Notification of Nondiscrimination

The Walton County School District offers the following career and technical programs through Emerald Coast Technical College, wherein students may earn industry certification: Administrative Office Specialist, Applied Cybersecurity, Automotive Service Technology 1, Automotive Service Technology 2, Computer Systems and Information Technology, Cosmetology, Pharmacy Tech, Electricity, Air-Conditioning, Refrigeration and Heating Technology 1, Air-Conditioning, Refrigeration and Heating Technology 2, Medical Administrative Specialist, Network Support Services, Patient Care Technician/CNA, Practical Nursing, Web Applications-Development and Programming, Welding Technology, Advanced Welding Technology, Global Logistics and Supply Chain Technology, Commercial Foods and Culinary Arts, Hospitality and Tourism. Interested persons must complete the appropriate application, provide high school transcripts and complete any required testing, if applicable, before being accepted into a program.
