

Florida's School Public Accountability Report (SPAR) Availability

As a requirement of federal No Child Left Behind legislation, Florida's School Public Accountability Reports (SPAR's) are published at the beginning of the school year. These reports measure the educational progress of schools, school districts, and the state.

These reports include information on student academic achievement, professional qualifications of teachers and staff, and school safety and environment. Such information helps measure the Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for individual schools, school districts, and the state.
