Dear Parent/Guardian of a WCSD Home Education Student:

I would like to take this opportunity to advise you that Florida Standards Assessments (FSA) and Next Generation Sunshine State Standards (NGSSS) Assessments will be administered in our district as shown on the chart on the back of this letter. As a reminder, state tests are one method of meeting your child's yearly evaluation requirement for Home Education. Please contact me at 850-892-1100, Ext: 1319 no later than 30 days prior to the test date for which you wish your child to test in order to register your child to be tested through our district. Planning time is necessary to make sure that we have an FLEID (Florida Education Identification) Number for your child as this is required by the state for your child to test, plus the school will need time to ensure they have the proper testing materials for your child.

Here are a few important things to remember concerning state testing:

- Please remember that if your child wishes to take the FSA ELA then he/she must complete both the Writing and the Reading portions of this test to earn a score. These tests are given at different times, so please be aware that your child will need to test for each of the dates in April and May.
- While on campus your child will be expected to follow all Walton County School District Code of Conduct policies to include Dress Code. For a copy of the Walton County School District Code of Conduct, please visit [www.walton.k12.fl.us](http://www.walton.k12.fl.us).
- If your child is not known to the test administrator either a picture ID such as a state issued photo ID, driver's license, military ID or in the event your child does not have a picture ID, a WCSD Proof of Identity form (enclosed) must be presented.
- Your child must be registered with Walton County School District as a Home Education student in order to take a state test in our district.
- You must contact me at 850-892-1100, 1319 at least 2 weeks prior to the test date to register your child to take the test.
- Student test results, once received, will be mailed to the address on file with the Home Education office.
