<p>Grades K-12: Walton County School District will annually provide instruction to students in grades K-12 related to child trafficking prevention and awareness. Using the health education standards adopted in Rule 6A-1.09401, the instruction for child trafficking prevention will advance each year through developmentally appropriate instruction and skill building.</p> <p>Age-appropriate elements of effective and evidence-based programs and instruction to students in grades K-12 related to child trafficking prevention and awareness and must address, at a minimum, the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Recognition of signs of human trafficking; (b) Awareness of resources, including national, state and local resources; (c) Prevention of the abuse of and addiction to alcohol, nicotine, and drugs; (d) Information on the prevalence, nature, and strategies to reduce the risk of human trafficking, techniques to set healthy boundaries, and how to safely seek assistance; and (e) Information on how social media and mobile device applications are used for human trafficking. <p>These standards will be implemented in the selected courses above to ensure instruction is delivered to all students. Course(s) for delivery will be determined by each site.</p>

<p>Grades K-12: Instruction will be delivered in whole group lecture, groups and individually. Instructors will utilize district selected programs for instruction with facilitated discussions and lessons.</p>
